David Hutchings, affectionately known as Dave and Papa, left us on Jan.31, 2024, in Newberg, OR. He was born June 24, 1937, in Pomona, CA.

He pursued his love for learning at the University of the Pacific, where he earned a degree in teaching, with majors in Art and History. His educational journey set the stage for his lifelong career as a High School Art and History teacher. Dave's interests went beyond the classroom. Dave's love for nature was another hallmark of his life, often found hiking and serving as a docent for numerous Nature Parks, sharing his knowledge and love for the outdoors with others.
