Peter Lawrence Pustorino of Windsor passed away peacefully on November 16, 2021 at the age of 75.

Peter was born in Yonkers, New York to Ernest & Florence Pustorino. He was the second of three children. After graduating high school, Peter enlisted in the U.S. Army. Peter was a decorated Vietnam Veteran who served his country with honor. In 1987, he married his love, Valerie and together they raised their daughter, Angela Jean. Peter worked as an appraiser for most of his life, but when he retired, he dedicated himself to working with those in drug & alcohol rehabilitation. He loved helping others and also volunteered at Biella elementary school. Pete's greatest love was playing the bass with the Windsor Jazz Ensemble. He was most happy playing when his daughter Angie was singing. Pete played guitar most of his life and was a soulful singer and player.

Peter leaves behind to cherish his memory, his beloved wife of 34 years, Valerie Pustorino; daughter, Angela Jean Pustorino; sister, Lisa (Mark) Edmiston; brother, Ernest (Marcie) Pustorino; and many loving nieces and nephews.

A Private service was held, but no funeral will take place at Pete's request. A Celebration of Pete's life will be held in the spring, details still to come.

To celebrate his life, we have set up a Memorial Grove in Peter's name through an organization called Trees for a Change.

The trees will be planted in a National Forest that was destroyed by wildfire. Peter's trees will help restore the beauty of the forest and will be a living tribute to him for years to come. 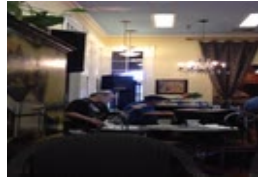
