GALLO, RONALD, a beloved father, brother, grandfather, and friend, passed away on March 8, 2024, in Santa Rosa, California, just shy of his 89th birthday.

Born in New York on March 16, 1935, to Joe and Elma Gallo, Ronald's journey was one of adventure, service, and creativity. His formative years took him from New York to Michigan for grade school, and later to Bowling Green, Ohio, for high school. Ronald's talents shone through in his painting business, later transitioning to work in a pottery yard, and eventually at Dillion with Dynamometers as an assembly tech and tester. His work ethic, creativity, and dedication to craftsmanship were evident in all he undertook.
